

Our Mission

TEENS. Inc. is a not-for-profit 501 (c)(3) organization, that provides training for at-risk youth and individuals with disabilities. We serve the City of Winchester, Frederick, Clarke, Warren and surrounding counties.

Our vocational agriculture (VoAg) program's primary objective is to prepare students to enter the workforce better equipped to obtain and maintain gainful employment.

Our students learn to grow vegetables, such as lettuce, tomatoes and herbs using aquaponics and traditional growing methods. In addition, they are introduced to a variety of tools and techniques to hone their skills. TEENS also provides job application and interview training.

At TEENS, Inc., we recognize the importance of skill acquisition as a means to independence and good citizenship. Young people need encouragement, support, and guidance. That is exactly what our programs provide.

Our Teaching Methods

Not every teenager flourishes in a traditional school setting and that is why TEENS is designed as a hands-on model program. By actively doing, teens learn how to cope, think critically, and collaborate to become independent citizens.

At TEENS, bright and enthusiastic kids also learn how to prepare for opportunities within the growing alternative energy market. This unique field-based training program provides an excellent background in Science, Technology, Engineering, & Math (S.T.E.M.)

Teaching Methods, Cont'd

The learning environment includes exposure to traditional agricultural skills and modern aquaponic methodologies. In addition, our young people learn the landscaping business, including equipment maintenance, landscape design, and construction techniques.

TEENS offer these inquisitive kids an opportunity to learn new skills, make business decisions, and prepare for exciting careers. Moreover, participants develop outstanding work ethics while learning job safety and teamwork.
